Standards of Service Military installation out-of-hospital services and EMS should, in all cases, meet or exceed the prevailing community standards for all aspects of EMS and out-of-hospital care. The military should establish standardized protocols employing best available evidence-based medicine principles.

On-duty EMS units shall be staffed with the minimum members necessary for emergency medical care relative to the level of EMS provided by the fire department. o AND two members trained at the BLS level arriving on scene within the established travel time.
