Do you have consumer rights if you sell products in Ireland?

If You Sell Products to Consumers Consumers buying from businesses based in Ireland or the EU have strong consumer rights. These rights are part of the Consumer Rights Act 2022 and apply to products you sell on or after 29 November 2022. This page covers your key responsibilities under consumer law on:

What is a place of supply in Ireland?

As per the above,where goods are not dispatched or transported (i.e.,they remain in Ireland),the place of supply is where the goods are physically located at the time of supply. Therefore,subject to Irish VAT at the appropriate rate. EU &NI: The place of supply differs where the supply is made to non-VAT registered persons.

Does XYZ supply a service outside Ireland?

There are certain specified services where the place of supply is outside Ireland if the customer is located outside the EU. XYZ ltd.,an Irish company,supplies a service to Karl,a non-business customer based in Germany. The service does not come within one of the exceptions or use and enjoyment provisions.

It is not sufficient to merely label a product in conformity to national requirements. For the development of a product's full market potential,quality,price,packaging and after-sales service are key. U.S. exporters may also wish to consider warehousing in Irelandfor expeditious supply and service for customers in Ireland and Europe.
