Why did Namibia build a water recycling plant?

Additional water infrastructure was needed in order to meet water demand. Recognizing that wastewater is a valuable resource, Namibia decided to reuse it. They built the Goreangab Water Reclamation Plant, the first water recycling plant in the world to recycle municipal wastewater into drinking water, which is known as direct potable reuse (DPR).
