Since 1943 the Army and Navy operated a telecommunications facility in Asmara, Ethiopia, called Kagnew Station. In 1973, the Army ceased operations at Kagnew, but the Station remained a ...

Kagnew Station is a United States military radio receiving and transmitting facility located since 1942 at Asmara on the Ethiopian highlands.

Second Lieutenant Clay Littleton arrived in Eritrea April 30, 1943 to begin a feasibility study as to whether or not Asmara would be suitable for a projected War Department fixed radio station.

A 25-year lease is signed between the governments of the United States and Ethiopia to establish a military communications base at Kagnew Station in Asmara.
